

LOCAL CIRCUIT BH1: DANSON PARK AND BOSTALL WOODS

- 5.57 miles

Linked churches:

Welling (start and finish)

Bexleyheath Christ Church (Direction 11B: Detour – see Appendix)

Bexleyheath St Peter (16)

Bostall Heath (21)

Roads and hindrances:

Beyond usual prudence there are no significant traffic issues. Danson Road is busy (Direction 4), but there is a light-controlled crossing.

On entering Bostall Woods (23), the second of the left-turns (the one down into the woods) comes very soon and is easily missed. The fallen trees (27) are, we might hope, a temporary feature.

Notes taken: June and July 2020

The start and finish is at Welling Church, Danson Lane, DA16 2BQ.

1		Start at the point on Danson Lane where the driveway from Welling Church meets it. Go up, not the driveway itself, but the roadway on its right, the other side of the fence, leading into Danson Park.	468 755	
		Park opening times currently advertised (June 2020): 7.30 weekdays, 9.00 weekends and bank holidays; closing 4.30 or sunset, whichever is the later.		
2	5	Pass various facilities on the left, including toilets (currently open). Continue ahead along the road, on its left-hand side now, to avoid being diverted by a fence which soon appears.		
3	11	Pass through the first gates.		
4		At the second gates turn right and use the nearby light- controlled crossing to go over the main road and set out along Bean Road opposite.		0.56
5	16	[Map point] At the T-junction at the end turn left, then immediately follow the road's right swing.		
6	19	At the end, cross over the road and continue ahead, passing a traffic barrier and going ahead along the roadway.		
7	21	Swing left with the road.		
8	22	Turn right at the T-junction.		
9	23	And then left at the T-junction at the end, into Lion Road.		
10	25	Turn right into the main road (Bexleyheath Broadway), and cross as soon as possible.	485 754

11B	3	Reach Christ Church on the left.		0.14
		After visiting the church, retrace your steps to the Church Road junction.		
11C	5	Rejoin the main route, by turning right along Church Road, as from Direction 11.		0.28
		Add 5 minutes to subsequent total times and 0.28 miles to cumulative distances.

FOR THOSE WHO WALK WITH THEIR DOGS

I do not venture to give advice about walking with your dog. As well as the joys, you will be well aware of the issues involved, and particularly that relationships between dogs and other countryside animals potentially involve mutual suspicion, or worse.

But what this footnote does try to do, in response to requests, is to give some indication of the nature of the walk from a dog's point of view, to enable you to decide whether it is suitable.

The percentage distances on the right (on the next page) should be self-explanatory.

The information in the middle column may look a bit cluttered, but I think it should enable you (if the detail is of interest) to mark up within a few minutes a print-out of the walk notes, so that you have some idea what might be round the next corner.

The risk in all this is that <u>things change so quickly</u> in the agricultural working world; and what I describe might become misleading after subsequent changes. I have done my best, but there is no guarantee that you will find the information up to date!
