

Preparation of a New Electoral Roll and 2025 Ash Parish Meetings

The Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) and the Parish Meeting for the election of Churchwardens will be held on Sunday 4 May in Ash Church, after the 10:00am service.

Every six years all churches have to prepare a new electoral roll. The old roll is discarded and everyone who wishes to take part in the APCM **must** complete a new application form. The deadline for completing the forms in time for the 2025 APCM is **Sunday 9 March**. Late applications cannot, by law, be accepted until after the APCM when additional names may be added to the roll.

The Annual Parish Meeting for the election of Churchwardens is open to all people on the church electoral roll and also to everyone who is on the register of local government electors and who lives in the ecclesiastical Parish of Ash.

Application forms for the electoral roll will be available in the church and from the Electoral Roll officer, Carol Clark (carol@cclark.me.uk – 01474 874526).

Under the Church Representation Rules any lay persons are entitled to have their names entered on the electoral roll if they—

- (i) are baptised and aged 16 or over (or have a 16th birthday in the next year);
- (ii) have signed a form of application for enrolment;

and either:

(iii) are members of the Church of England or of any Church in communion with the Church of England being resident in the parish or (not being resident in the parish) having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to the application for enrolment;

or:

(iv) are members in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity declaring themselves also to be members of the Church of England and having habitually attended public worship in the parish during the period of six months prior to enrolment.

If you are not resident in the parish but were on the roll as an habitual worshipper and have been prevented by sickness or absence or other essential reason from worshipping for the past six months, you may write "would" before "have habitually attended" on the form and add "but was prevented from doing so because" and then state the reason.

Two members of the PCC will retire by rotation each year at the APCM and although they will be eligible for re-election, nominations for any church member who has been on the electoral roll for at least 6 months and is at least 16 years of age are always welcomed.

Churchwardens must be elected annually and whilst two are needed to ensure that the work does not fall on one person, Ian Nurdin has been our only churchwarden for several years and he would welcome support from a second person. Any church member who is on the electoral roll and at least 21 years old, is eligible to be a churchwarden.

Nominations for PCC members and churchwardens should be on forms obtainable from the PCC secretary, Cameron Clark (cameron@cclark.me.uk – 01474 874526) and, for PCC members, must be signed by two people who are on the current electoral roll. Churchwardens must be nominated by two people who are on either the current church electoral roll or the register of local government electors in Ash ecclesiastical parish.


Rev Helen is Stepping Down
